Vision Statement

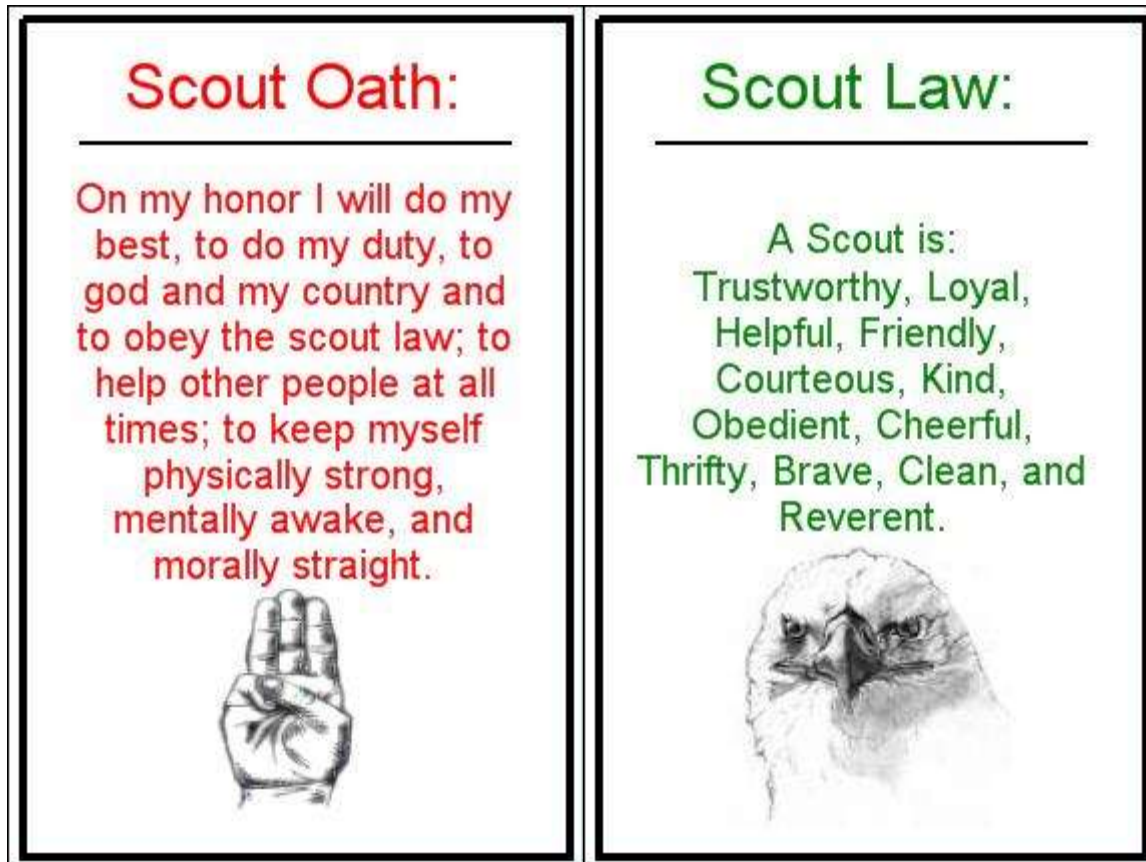
The Boy Scouts of America is the nation's foremost youth program of character development and values-based leadership training.
