Intro to Scoutbook

What is Scoutbook?

- a web application that can be used from your computer or mobile devices.
- a suite of easy-to-use Web-based tools that are helpful to Scouts, parents and unit leaders.
- enables units to easily communicate, update records, track advancement & activities

- Track Troop 113 Leaders, Patrols and Scout information.
- Track Scout Journey, Rank and Merit Badge Achievements

What Can Parents Do in Scoutbook?

- **Profile:** View & Edit Personal information for you and your scout– address, email, health information, council information, membership info, add a picture
- **Advancement:** Gives the connected user the right to view all of their Scouts' advancement data including notes posted by leaders.
